



**CONTACT LENS SERVICES UNDER YOUR VISION INSURANCE COVERAGE**

Your vision insurance provides you with minimum basic eye care. The provisions include a refraction (spectacle lens determination) and basic eye health testing.

Although your insurance may provide a stipend toward contact lenses, evaluating the fit, condition and prescription of your contact lenses and your cornea is not a covered expense. In order to properly render this vital service to you, an additional fee\* will be charged to you.

If your contact lens prescription has expired, you will not be able to reorder contacts until the fit of the lens has been evaluated this year. This contact lens evaluation is an annual requirement in order for you to order contact lenses, whether or not the prescription has changed.

The fee is due today – the day service is rendered.

\*This fee varies from \$49 to \$199 depending on the complexity of your prescription. Your eye doctor will advise you of the specific amount before proceeding with the contact lens evaluation. This fee is for professional time and services rendered and is non-refundable. The fee is non-refundable even if you decide against wearing contact lenses.
